Steps for Successful Completion of Independent Study Courses

1. **Decide which course meets your needs.**
2. **Complete both pages of the *Application for Independent Study* form (maximum of 4 enrollments per form).**
3. **Provide appropriate authorizing signatures.**
4. **Mail or deliver completed *Application for Independent Study* form and payment of total costs to the Department of Independent Study.**
5. **Prepare and maintain a course activity schedule.**
6. **Complete and submit Examination Proctor Form to Department of Independent Study.**
7. **Organize and prepare lessons neatly for submission.**
8. **Keep copies of each lesson to be submitted until final course grade is received.**
9. **Mail or deliver the appropriate number of completed lessons per week to the Department of Independent Study.**
Lessons are counted for the date that they are received, not the date they are mailed.
10. **Ask questions.**
